How do I register for a class?

You may either register online or by calling the Education Administrator at 414-290-5393.

What is the difference between Basic Acting and Acting for the Camera?

Basic Acting is geared towards live theater auditioning and acting skills such as monologue work, text analysis, scene partner studies, and in-depth character creation. Acting for the Camera is geared towards on-screen presence, basic film technology, and the industry tips and tricks.

Where do I go when I get to Milwaukee Rep?

Your class will take place in one of our professional rehearsal halls where our actors rehearse before transitioning to one of our three stages. You'll enter The Rep's complex through reception which is located to the right of our Ticket Office. You'll be asked to sign the guest list, and then will proceed to the 4th floor. The rehearsal halls are directly to the left of the elevator lobby. There will be signs posted to direct you.

What should I wear?

If you are participating in the Basic Acting Series or in our Stage Combat course then you are encouraged to wear movable clothing and comfortable shoes. If you are participating in our Acting for the Camera series we ask that you dress in the best representation of yourself.

What do I bring?

Some participants prefer to bring a water bottle, pencil, and notebook.

What do I do if I'll be absent?

Please notify both your Teaching Artist and the Education Administrator. As actors we collaborate and much of our work is partner-dependent. We ask that you participate in all sessions so you are there for your partner. We encourage you to notify us in advance on conflicts before class begins so that we can prepare for your absence.

What is your refund policy?

We do not give refunds any later than 2 weeks prior to a class's start date. After that date, we do give class credit that you can apply to any other Adult Acting class. Contact the Education Administrator.

When do I pay for the class?

We expect full payment when you register for a class either online or by calling 414-290-5393.

When are different sections offered?

Please keep checking the website for up to date schedule of Adult Acting classes, or email the Education Administrator with specific questions.

What happens if I show up late?

If reception has closed for the evening, you will have to contact your Teaching Artist who will have to come let you in. There will be a sign posted on our door to our reception with the rehearsal hall's phone number. There is a phone located right of the door that you can use to call up to the rehearsal hall.

What are the prerequisites?

There are no prerequisites for any of our "I" level courses, such as Basic Acting I or Acting for the Camera I. For any classes designated with a "II" or a "III," you must have completed the previous courses or have demonstrated commensurate knowledge to the Education Administrator and Teaching Artist.

I'm a beginner! Where should I start?

Wonderful! We would suggest Basic Acting I or Acting for the Camera I depending on whether you are interested in live theater or TV/film acting respectively. You are also welcome to register for any of our Stage Combat courses.

I'm not a beginner, can I skip ahead?

Please contact the Education Administrator to see if your experience is commensurate to our introductory courses.

Do you offer audits or scholarships?
